Greetings everyone. November is here and that means it will soon be Thanksgiving. It seems redundant to say this, but it does sometimes get forgotten that Thanksgiving is a time for, well...giving thanks. To help us keep a spirit of gratitude in the forefront as we proceed through the month, let me call your attention to some spiritual practices to take advantage of here at Snow Creek.

One of the most important ways that we can show our appreciation to God is through community worship. This month offers us a special opportunity to do so with the



Community Thanksgiving Service on November 24 at Jones Chapel Church. Members of Snow Creek Christian Church, Trinity Baptist Church, Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church, and Jones Chapel Church of the Brethren will join together to offer thanks to God for his many blessings. This embodies the premise behind the original Thanksgiving celebration by bringing together a diverse group of people – whether they be Native Americans or Pilgrims, native-born or immigrants, Disciples or Baptists or Methodists or Brethren – to express gratitude to God. So, let us bring a big crowd to Jones Chapel on the 24th and here to Snow Creek each and every Sunday so that we can unite and give thanks. One important note that I do need to pass along is that the community service will be at 3:00 this year in order to make it easier for everyone to find their way home afterwards.

Alongside communal worship, let us remember to give thanks through intentional private prayer. There will be a lot to get done in the coming month. Let me remind you though that preparing for Thanksgiving means preparing to be thankful. Before you go to the grocery store or make your Black Friday shopping list or check that fire extinguisher next to the deep fryer, I challenge everyone to take five minutes, go through the past year in your mind, and truly give some thought to specific moments where you have received God's blessing. Right before you get started on your holiday preparations, offer these to God in prayer, maybe even write them down. It is a way to invite God into your celebration and to help keep perspective amidst the hustle and bustle.

Give thanks by offering God your time and attention you through study of the scripture. I have some homework for you all in this regard. I would like to hand out an Advent devotional booklet prepared in-house here at Snow Creek on the Sunday after Thanksgiving. This would include a scripture and a SHORT devotional for each day of Advent leading up to Christmas Day. There are more details elsewhere in the newsletter, but I would encourage all who feel moved to share their faith to submit a short devotion this month. This will help us as a community to spiritually prepare to celebrate the coming of Christ and show our thankfulness for the blessing He has been in our lives.

Finally, I would be remiss if I did not take this time to be thankful for the tremendous opportunity I have had to serve as your minister at Snow Creek Christian Church. Like the Pilgrims trying to survive in their new situation, I am extremely grateful for all of the help I have received in my new role. I look forward to the many opportunities I will have to give thanks for this with all of you in the month to come.



Advent Devotional



Contrary to popular belief, early December is really NOT supposed to be the Christmas season, at least not according to the church calendar. Traditionally, the Christmas season is the 12-day period including and following December 25 where we remember the time from Jesus' birth until his revelation to the world in the visit of the magi. Hence the song and the lords aleaping and the partridge in her pear tree.

The church season leading up to Christmas is Advent. It is the beginning of the church year, and is meant to be a time of waiting, longing, and preparing both for the celebration of Christ's coming and his prophesied second coming. To participate in this, I would like Snow Creek to experiment this year with creating an Advent devotional. This will be distributed and read during the Advent season as a way to prepare our hearts for the celebration of Christ's birth and when He will return in glory at the end of time. *So how does this work?*

- 1. **Sign up** There will be a clipboard going around the next few Sundays during announcements. Pick a scripture and write your name and email next to it.
- 2. **Read** Read the scripture and consider what it means to you, what it means in regards to the birth of Christ, or what it means in regards to Christ's second coming.
- 3. Write Write up a SHORT (around a paragraph or two) response to the reading. If you get stuck responding to the reading, simply write a devotional about what Christmas means to your faith.
- Name I would encourage everyone to put your name at the bottom of your devotional. If you would like to do one anonymously, that is fine. Just do not write your name on the actual devotional and I will put it in the booklet without one
- 5. **Return** Email them back to me at <u>soliver@vt.edu</u> by **November 10**. If you don't have email, give me a hard copy one Sunday or stick it in the church mailbox. Email is preferred.





