REFLECTIONS



I am grateful that I have this opportunity to share some Spring thoughts with my friends at Snow Creek.

There for a while, when we were having more rain days than sunshine, I wondered if we might want to start building another Ark! But the rainbow reminds us that God will never again flood the earth. However, it makes me wonder what those who

have lost everything to the most recent rain and flooding are thinking? It has certainly made it difficult to start my vegetable garden as my 82 X 60 plot has looked more like a rice paddy than my usual garden. But we all know that there is little we can do to change weather patterns. So, about all we can do is talk about it and hope for the best.

April has gotten here so quickly – why it was just a bit ago the we celebrated Christmas (we still have our poinsettias in the sunroom). Now we are well in Lent, that time when we prepare ourselves for the Resurrection event, we call Easter. The last days of Jesus were spent preparing somewhat for the Jewish Passover – the time when God freed his people from slavery and promised them a special land of their own. It appears that Jesus took this opportunity to offer freedom from the slavery of sin through his crucifixion, death, and resurrection.

It has been a tradition that we give up something during Lent – something that we would have difficulty giving up. I suppose some still do that – but I think that is something like New year's resolutions – they are either so easy or easy forgotten that they are mostly meaningless. It seems to me that this needs to be a time when we practice a bit of self-sacrifice even as our Lord gave his very self for us and our freedom from sin. In our culture self-sacrifice is an antiquated term and people mostly seek to get whatever they

can with less effort or expense. I know for myself I certainly have not sacrificed self anywhere like Jesus did for me. Maybe during this time of lent I may well be looking for some ways to give myself significance for others.

In seminary, I was exposed to those theologians who did not accept a literal resurrection and the explanations were about as ridiculous as those thinkers thought physical resurrection was. But if we put any credibility at all in what the Bible says how can anyone deny that Christ rose from the dead? The resurrection even is in all four Gospels and it spread throughout Acts and the Epistles. I like what Paul wrote to the *Corinthians* (15:12-14); "But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith".

Just lately I went to the Dollar Tree to check on some decorations for Easter and all I saw were eggs, bunnies, daffodils - not one word of mention as to what Easter is truly all about.

These actually have roots in Pagan worship but have been given Christian significance which is all right as long as one does not forget what Easter is truly about. Christ died for our sins so that we do not have to suffer guilt the rest of our lives – that without the burden of guilt our lives can be so much fuller.






