



Board Minutes

Snow Creek Christian Church Board Meeting

10-November-2019

G.B. called the meeting to order. Curtis had our opening prayer. Minutes were reviewed. Gusta made a motion to approve the minutes and Krystal seconded the motion, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report- Bud presented copies of the Treasurer's report focusing on several different areas. He had a copy of the 2019 YTD sources and uses of Outreach funds. Sources included budget, fund raisers and donations, etc. Funding uses included a list of local and non-local recipients. Bud was not sure of what was owed to the Disciples of Christ Organization fund.

Bud also had a copy of the Church's 3rd quarter checking accounts. This would include beginning and ending balances as well as receipts and expenditures from the main checking account, backpack checking account and rental checking account. He also had a very detailed listing for all the Church's transactions in those checking accounts for the month of October.

Doug made a motion to approve this report and Gusta seconded the motion, motion carried.

Pastor's Report- Scott said he has completed his second introductory class. He is now participating in an "Introduction to Worship" course. He said as part of this class he will have several assignments that he must complete with the congregation.

He was very excited about the joining of our new church members, Jared and Erica Pruett along with their sons Walker and Barrett. He also discussed several events the youth have enjoyed during this month. The youth are now working on the Christmas play and Christmas caroling may be in the future.

Scott said he has been involved in the planning of the Community Thanksgiving Service. He has also had talks with Lifetouch about the possibility of creating a directory for the Church. This would mean members would have photos taken that would be added in the directory. He said it would be at minimal cost to the church. Linda made motion to approve the church directory and Joyce seconded the motion, motion carried.

Committee Reports-

Property- Joyce asked who was ordering the tables for the reception hall. She also asked about shelving being put in the junk room so it could be organized. She is going to ask Kitty about the shelves she mentioned that they used in the store that were sturdy.

Outreach- Linda said the DOC (Disciples of Christ Committee) has to publicly know what the church

is involved in as far as Outreach. Linda said she also thought the church members need to have a better understanding as well and it should be discussed so the members know exactly where the monies are going.

Media- Vivian brought up the fact that we are still having issues with the on screen media during church service.

Fundraiser-

Old Business- Krystal said the speaker does not always work downstairs. G.B. will have Mike check on it to see if something is unplugged.

G.B. had the list of 2020 Church Officers. He thought some of the newer Acolytes may need some training. He also thought they should be added to the list of Officers. Vivian made a motion to approve the list of officers and Gusta seconded the motion, motion carried.

G.B. had a copy of the Pastors Contract for the Year 2020. There had been a few changes made. There was an increase of \$200.00 a month in the Pastor's salary. Board members wanted to encourage Scott to keep up with and turn in his mileage so he could be reimbursed. He has not turned any mileage in up to this point and he has made some long trips visiting church members in the hospital, etc.

Bud made a motion to approve the Pastor's Contract and Joyce seconded the motion, motion carried.

New Business- Bud had the Purposed Operating Budget for 2020. The Operating Budget included Ministerial Expenses, Property Expenses, Christian Education, Worship, Membership and

Outreach.

There were a couple of minor changes or re-allocations made. Gusta made a motion to pass the Budget and Linda seconded the motion, motion passed.

The Budget will be presented to the Congregation November 17th for the members to vote on.


