appy new year's! The old year was certainly an interesting one at Snow Creek Christian Church. As with the rest of the world, the church spent much of that year struggling to keep the COVID-19 virus at bay. Unfortunately, that struggle does not appear to be one that will be left behind in 2021. However, after spending much of the year worshipping in the parking lot, we were able to celebrate the resumption of indoor worship services this past month.



Up-to-date vaccinations do however still seem to be highly effective at either preventing infections or lessening the effects of the disease. I would strongly encourage everyone to get either vaccinated or a booster shot as this is the most effective way to protect both yourself and the rest of those who come to worship with you.

Thus, we know some of both the joys and concerns that 2022 will bring. There will certainly be many more unexpected ones of either type to follow. Let us strive to meet all of them with a steadfast faith in God, a hope for God's world, and love for each other. I look forward to an exciting and blessed 2022 with all of you.


