

Board Minutes

14-August-2022

G.B. called the meeting to order. Scott had our opening prayer. Minutes were reviewed. Barbara made a motion to approve the minutes and Doug seconded the motion, motion earned.

Treasurer's Report- Bud was not present for the meeting. G.B. reported that Bud had told him we had a very good month in July's offerings. The month included Cayden Price and backpack donations that were essentially in and out. We also had a higher expense month because of insurance premiums that were paid.

Pastor's Report- Scott reported that after meeting with the middle school parents in the church they have decided to resume Sunday school for the kids each Sunday. This is a part of getting those who have not been baptized prepared for baptism. The intention is to have the baptisms coincide with next year's Easter Sunday service.

They also discussed several other dates for fall events that would involve the youth. On Sunday, 10/30 the plan is to have the Halloween Trunk of Treat from 6-8 in the parking lot. On that same Sunday, the plan is to have youth Sunday since that would be the 5" Sunday of the month. The backpack offering would also be taken up that Sunday. They also discussed getting approval from the board to include the Christmas play as part of the worship service on 12/11. Of the board members that were present, everyone seemed to be in agreement with that date.

Scott asked if we were planning to have a Fall festival this year. In the past, prior to covid, the church has hosted a Fall festival, which included a breakfast. The date that was discussed is 10/1. There will be further discussions.

Old Business- G.B. has spoken with Green Memorial Park, a group that maintains cemeteries. He has also been in contact with CD Prillaman. CD told G.B. it would be late October or early November before he can invest any time into getting together all the records that would include the existing deceased burial plots and current plot holders.

New Business- We also discussed having the Community Thanksgiving service this year. The last service was in 2019 because of covid. This will have to be discussed further with the other churches.


