
Thanksgiving Special Offering

Church Board Minutes

G.B. called the meeting to order. Scott had our opening prayer. Minutes were reviewed. Kay made a motion to approve the minutes and Vivian seconded the motion, motion carried.

<u>**Treasurer's Report</u>**- Bud said that donations for Caden Price had continued to come in after Homecoming Sunday and those now totaled over \$6000.00. Jadie sent out a huge thank you to the church for their contributions. Bud said it was a typical month in offerings. Heating oil was delivered which made the operating expenses higher. GB said the septic system was another added expense. A pipe collapsed and they had to dig 5 feet to replace it. Everything else was good. Joyce made a motion to approve the report and Doug seconded the motion, motion carried.</u>

Pastor's Report- Scott reported he and the youth had resumed the Sunday school class for the middle school age kids. The class is designed to be a preparation for baptism on Easter 2023. Scott said the annual Trick or Treat is scheduled for Sunday, October 30 from 6-8. Scott said there probably would not be a joint Thanksgiving service this year.

Scott talked to Bugman Exterminating and they are planning to spray inside the church on their next visit. Scott has a meeting with a judge on Friday, September 16 to be granted official marriage celebrant status so he can perform the service for Nick and Emily's wedding on September 24. He also had been involved in pre-marital counseling for Nick and Emily. The cost of that was \$35.00 for each for a total of \$70.00 and Scott covered that cost. Joyce made a motion to reimburse Scott the \$70.00 and Linda seconded the motion, motion carried. Linda made a motion that going forward we add the couple counselling as part of outreach to provide couples that were associated with the church that same counselling as preparation for their upcoming marriage. Joyce seconded that motion, motion carried.

Scott will be resuming classes at Lexington Theological Seminary beginning the last week in September. He said his tentative completion time of classes would be 2024.

<u>Outreach</u>- Linda is looking at organizations we gave to last year to see if we wanted to continue this year. She also needs an up to date list of the names of those we would like to give Christmas baskets. Scott said he would work to put together an updated list.

<u>Old Business</u>- G.B. said Don Wilson suggested talking to an attorney in regards to the cemetery. There are many unknowns. The Prillamans are still trying to come up with documents as to who has existing plots for future burials. There could potentially be a lot of liability and expense for the church to consider weighing the conveyance of the cemetery over to the church. It currently costs \$100.00 to mow which everyone agreed was extremely low


considering the size and detail required to mow around the head stones. GB said once they have more information it would be something that would need to be presented to the congregation

Our Audiovisual Tech Team hard at work


Thank you to the amazing youth that operate the audiovisual equipment at Church during the worship service. We appreciate all you do.
