# Reflections

have always found March to be a weird month. Is it still winter or is it time to celebrate spring? From year to year the groundhog can never decide and from day to day it is hard for us to either. It is said to come in like a lion and go out like a lamb, but I have seen years of sub-freezing temperatures and even snow in late March, not to mention the occasional thunderstorm or tornado. The new year always begins in the dead of winter and by the time we get to March I am ready for something different. March always seems a bit of a tease as to when spring will come and when it does whether it will be here to stay.

It is the time of preparation. we are in the midst of the understated season of Lent, where we are called to repent and turn our full attention back to the gift of that Resurrection that we are getting ready to celebrate. If you have chosen to give up something for Lent or adopt a Lenten discipline, March marks that tough middle period where the rubber meets the road. This year it is the stretch where the early enthusiasm will start to fade but Easter still seems a ways out.

This is the time when the plants begin to bud and the grass begins to green and grow. Nature is doing all of its hidden work to soon blossom. It may not seem like much is going on in March but keep doing the spiritual work that will help you to blossom as well. March can at times be maddening, but keep on keeping on in your faith with an eye to the renewal of Resurrection.



Scott wanted to thank the Outreach Committee for taking care of the annual contributions and for purchasing the fruit baskets that will be distributed over the holidays. Scott said the plan is to deliver most of those as part of the youth caroling event planned for December 18°,

The Christmas Eve service will be on Saturday, December 24 at 9. Scott still needs some volunteers to read scripture as part of that service.

Scott will be gone 2 weeks in January and Rev. Bob Mooty will fill in as guest preacher. Scott said there had been discussion in regards to cancelling the January board meeting due to his absence. The board agreed to cancel January's meeting. Scott said he would like to suggest inviting Regional Minister, Bill Spangler-Dunning to speak at homecoming in 2023. Someone will reach out.
