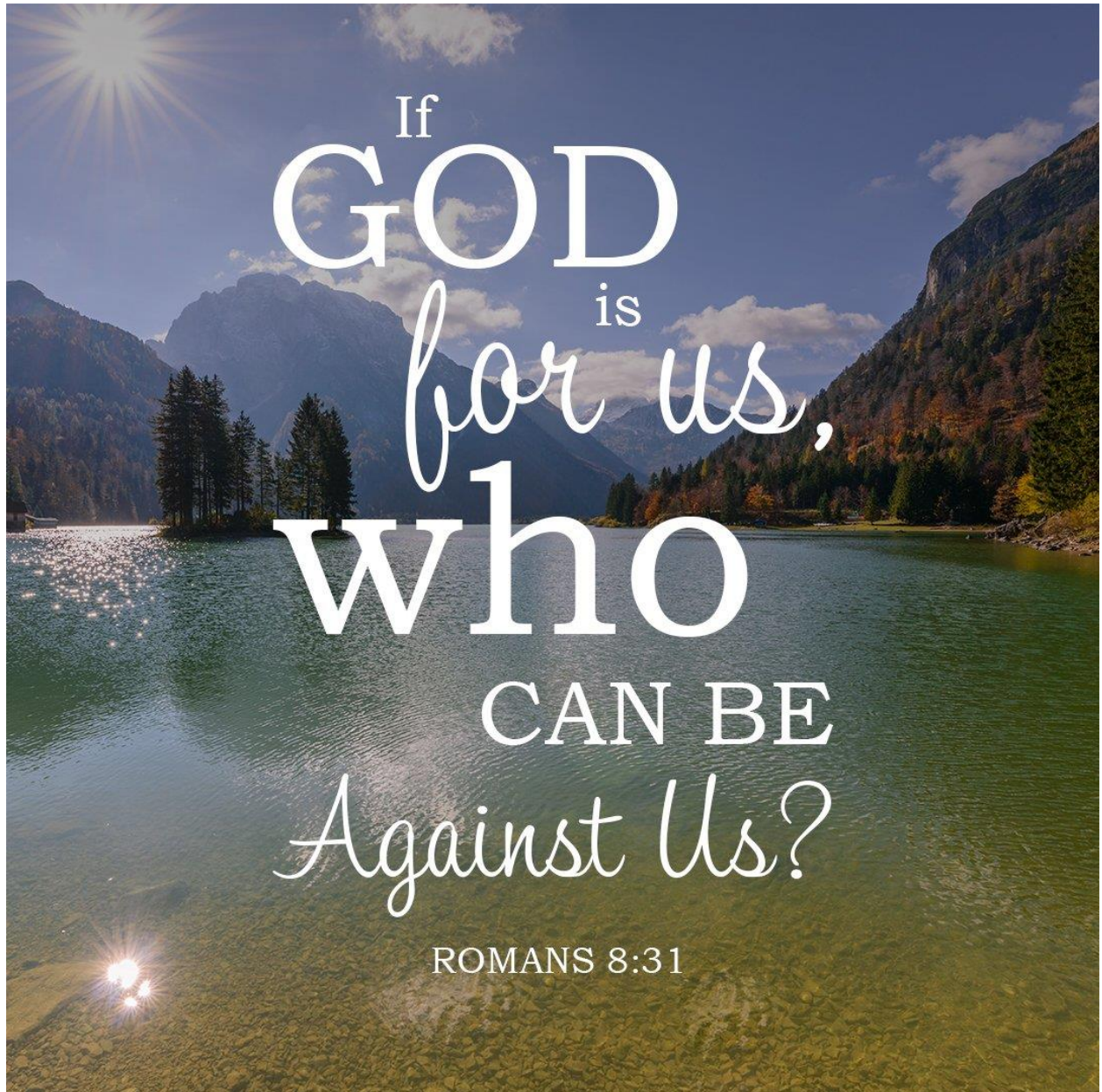
And I for one am looking forward to the cooler temperatures!

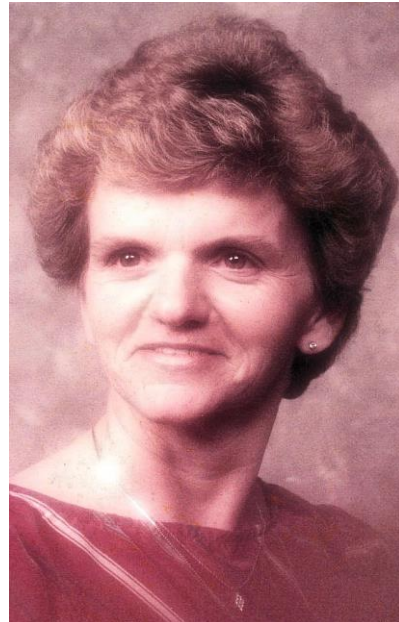
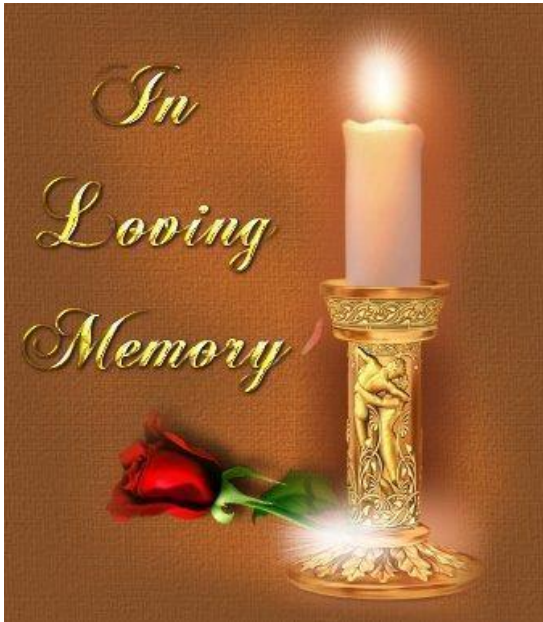

Baked Beans with Hamburger

- 2 strips of bacon cut in small
- 1 medium onion chopped
- 1 lb. ground beef
- 2 1 lb. cans of pork n' beans
- ½ cup molasses or dark Karo syrup
