

Reflections

I don't know. That has become my standard answer for any church related questions right now. This is not the answer that anyone wants to hear. I am learning very quickly though that anyone who says that they have better answers is usually full of something other than the Holy Spirit. It is a frustrating answer, but one that just about everyone and every institution is having to wrestle with right now.

As Christians, we should be better prepared to handle 'I don't know' than most. The stories we have been taught are full of I don't know situations.

"Moses, when are we ever going to make it to this Promised Land you keep talking about?"

"Jesus, how are we supposed to feed all of those people?"

"How are twelve people supposed to spread this message to the ends of the earth?" 'I don't know' points us to faith. God does know and humanity often has to settle for operating on a need-to-know basis. 'I don't know' forces us to look to God for guidance and, even scarier, to place our fate in God's hands. Personally, I need to work on this faith, because I want to know. I want to know when it will be safe to bring people together for worship, I want to know what that will look like.

One of my goals for the next few weeks is to continue to search for the answers to those questions. However, another goal is to do so with a renewed sense of patience and humility. God will see us through to worshipping together again, I have to keep in mind though, that worshipping God should be done on God's terms.

In the meantime, I encourage everyone to continue to seek God in prayer and to continue to lift up names of those who need your prayers. I encourage everyone to continue to take communion each Sunday as a reminder of God's continued presence and all that God has already done for us. I encourage everyone to continue in all of the kind gestures that I have repeatedly heard from so many different people. And finally, I encourage everyone to keep faith, to be patient and humble through this situation in ways that have occasionally eluded me. God has the answers and will share in good time.

Ellen Holland, Executive Director of the Free Clinic receives our church's donation from Linda Hippisley, Chair of the Outreach Committee "Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink?' Free Clinic of Franklin County, Inc. and Bernard Healthcare Center provide primary medical care and medications at little or no cost for uninsured and underinsured <u>adults</u> in Franklin County. Care is provided on a sliding scale payment system. No insurance required. After completing a registration and financial eligibility form, the clinic will determine what fees will be charged for a visit. Clinic fees range from \$5.00 to \$95.00 depending on income.

The medical clinic is open Monday - Thursday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Services include:

- Primary medical care
- Non-emergency urgent care
- Chronic care/Case management
- Lab work & Diagnostics (limited)
- Women's wellness
- Diabetes management, education, and eye exams
- Prescription medications (\$3 processing fee)
- Sports physicals
- Flu tests/shots
- Tuberculosis tests (PPD)
- Specialist & imaging referrals

The Clinic receives no federal funds; they operate on town and county supplements, grants and community donations from businesses, churches, and individuals.

Volunteer Opportunities: Volunteers can work a few hours a week, a month or a few times a year as their schedule allows.

<u>Professional Volunteers</u>: Physicians, Dentists, Clinical Psychologists or Social Workers, Nurses, Medical Assistants, etc. to provide clinical services.

<u>Administrative Volunteers</u> to help register patients, file, and help with administrative tasks.

<u>Legal Volunteers</u>: Attorneys to provide legal guidance as needed

.**Event Volunteers**: Assistants for fundraising events may help with set-up and cleanup, Register participants, hand out programs, keep the area clean, and provide a variety of on-the-spot needs.
